Nine Lives of a Marriage, a curious journey by local authors Mickey Goodman and Eva Friedlander is a great read.

This newly released independently published book is a unique memoir of Friedlander who along with her now deceased husband George, survived the Holocaust in Hungary. In addition to both living day-to-day in a constant state of fear during WWII, the reader is also taken, from Friedlander's perspective, inside the home, life, and heart of a woman who shared her husband with another, for 45 years.

Friedlander's memoir is captured so well by Goodman, it's hard to comprehend that two people worked on this book. Spry and witty, Friedlander still lives in Atlanta and at 89-years-old, is excited about her first book.
